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Content

The LC course is composed of two parts. Part I, a video option with an on-site introduction, a 2-workshop and an examination part. In Part II, on-site lectures, 3 workshops with presentations and their defence, interim examination.

LC looks at three ecumenical (Apostolic, Nicean and Athanasian) creeds and Lutheran Confessions (excluding Luther's catechisms) in a concentrated but complex way, from a Biblical, systematic and historical point of view. In addition to Ecumenical Creeds, particular attention is paid to the presentation and analysis of the Augsburg Confession (1530) and its Apology, as well as the Treatise and Formula of Concord as the theological comment of the Augsburg Confession and further development, pointing to their content in modern relationships, interactions, interdisciplinary links, as well as to the use of the Book of Concord in faith practice, in serving in congregation and in society.

Aims:

- To introduce students to LC;
- to deepen their understanding of the content of Lutheran confessional faith;
- promote their ability to present this content rationally and justify it.
