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Content (Course Annotation)

In this course, students get a deeper insight into the history of the Church in Latvia (HCL), which has been developed since the baptism of Livonia until the end of Soviet time. The path of Christianity has been relatively difficult and complicated in this area, and it is not easy to track it. However, this has clearly been important and has left a lasting trail in the formation of the Latvian nation. The course will look at the main events and personalities of this church's history, the successes and failures of the Christianization. Historical and theological analysis will describe and evaluate the main phases and milestones of this unpalatable history, providing both overview and essential details.

Aims

- To deepen students' awareness of the history of the Church of Latvia;
- promoting the ability of students to understand the development of HCL in the context of overall history;
- develop the ability of students to discern and justify the importance of HCL today.
