Content

The study course gives an insight into the differences between the faiths and practices of the five Christian denominations that historically have been unified in Latvia in the ecumenical dialogue. Students will be presented with orthodox (Orthodox), Roman Catholic, Baptist, Adventist and Pentecostal traditions, their formation, theological differences, the number of believers, supreme authorities in matters of faith, dogmas, administration, internal structure, clergy, canonical texts, mysticism, treatment of other denominations, sacraments, liturgy, theological language, calendar, fasting and thoughts on the afterlife. According to similar criteria, new religious movements are also examined, which, by their very nature, are syncretic (Bahá'í), partly associated with Christian tradition (Mormons, Jehovah witnesses), or present in Latvia unconnected with Christianity (dievturi, Krishna consciousness movement, Sai Baba, etc.).

As part of the course, the lecturer shall first give a theoretical insight into the specific tradition, followed by a presentation and discussion with students by a representative or expert of a particular religion or religious movement.

Aims

- To promote the understanding of the ecumenical nature of the prayer by Jesus, "let them all be alone" (Jn 17:22), in the context of Lutheran theology;
- to encourage the continuation and development of cooperation in the context of the ecumenical dialogue;
- to discover the fundamental differences between Christian and non-Christian religious movements.

- the main differences between the largest Christian Attendance denominations of Latvia;

- adequately discuss the special approaches of Latvia's largest Christian denominations to grooming Christian spirituality in catechic and ecumenical parenting of their parishioners;
- differentiate between the various new religious movements and see common and different between them;
- recognize the representatives of different religious trends and explain their differences with Christian tradition in a reasoned way.
