Content (Course Annotation)

This study course provides basic knowledge of the requirements of Latvia and the EU and their implementation in the protection of the environment, civil and work conditions. Students shall acquire requirements for the workplace, risks to the working environment, electrical safety, fire safety, emergency situations, basic principles for the assessment and response of civil protection, rights and obligations under the law of the RL.

Aims

The objective of the study course is to present to students the International Labour Protection Conventions, the labour protection and labour laws, regulations, etc. regulatory documents.

Learning Outcomes

Knowledge

The students will know:

- organization, operation and financing principles of the national civil protection system;
- the rights and obligations of the population in the event of disasters;
- simple methods for measuring and reducing risk levels;
- work and environmental protection sites and roles in the activities of institutions, businesses and municipalities

Skills

The students will be able to:

- establishing a work and civil protection system within the organization;
- use the simplest personal protective equipment;
- to perform employee briefings at the workplace, to train employees for safe working methods;
- to provide first emergency aid;
- establishing and completing the necessary documentation regarding the involvement of resources in response measures, firefighting or rescue works;

- comply with fire safety and environmental protection rules;

Competencies

The students will be able to:

- collect and process environmental information;
- analyse different events, take emergency decisions;
- ensure compliance with the regulatory enactments regarding fire safety and environmental protection at the facility;
- develop a positive and responsible attitude towards civil protection measures as an important and necessary State function in each installation, public, state or local government institution.
